## CARING FOR DER DAU HANDCRAFTED BOOTS

## Supplies

We recommend using the following specially sourced Der Dau Leather & Boot Care products:

• Boot Cleaner

Boot Bag

• Conditioner

• Boot Trees

• Polish

## Instructions\*

1. CLEANING Debris, dirt, and salt can cause leather to harden and crack. Upon completion of each riding day, use a dampened cloth or sponge to thoroughly clean your boots.

TIP: NEVER use saddle soap, oil soap, hydrophane, neat's-foot oil, tanner's oil, and harsh solvents and cleaners. These products can remove color, crack the leather and/or make it greasy.

- 2. CONDITIONING Evenly apply a light layer of conditioner with a sponge. We recommend conditioning boots twice a week. Der Dau leather conditioner is designed to help keep fine leathers soft and pliable, while also preparing it perfectly for polishing.
- 3. POLISHING Polishing creates a beautiful shine and protects leather by creating a barrier from the elements. Apply Der Dau shoe wax with clean cloth or dauber and rub well into leather. Wait 15 minutes before removing polish with a brush. Brush boots several times. Finish with a soft clean cloth for high gloss.
- **4. STORAGE** It is imperative to dry your boots thoroughly after each ride. Once dry, slip your boot trees inside each boot and store at room temperature in a boot bag.

TIP: Never put wet boots near a heat source to dry. To prevent mildew, do NOT store in a damp area.

\*Note: Always follow manufacturer's directions for leather cleaning products.
